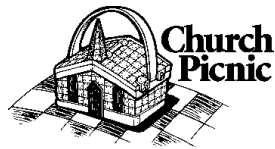

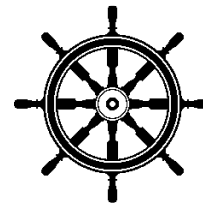

### **Healing Hearts of Waukesha County**

The Rainbows program has been in existence for over 20 years and helped over 2.2 million children, youth and adults deal with loss due to death, divorce, separation, incarceration, and military deployment. Waukesha County did not have a peer-to-peer support group until now. Salem was approached in October to be on the ground floor of starting a support group for children and adults. Marie has been the representative for Salem, joining First UMC, Southminster Presbyterian, St. William, St. Marks, Ascension Lutheran, and two funeral homes, in the forming of **Healing Hearts of Waukesha County**, a non-profit organization to help grieving children and the adults who care for them.



Marie is on the executive board and is the secretary for all meetings. The group is in the process of marketing, publishing materials, fundraising, and recruiting volunteers to facilitate groups. The plan is to hold the first 14-week session starting in October. The first session will be held at First UMC. If you would be interested in helping to facilitate a group of children or adults, or you might want to donate monies toward this ministry, please see Marie. The sessions are held free of charge to the families so that all may participate.

This is such a vital ministry to children, youth, and adults who are grieving. **Healing Hearts** will give them an opportunity to come together with others who are feeling the same grief and loss, to talk and listen, and to receive support and encouragement to start the healing process.

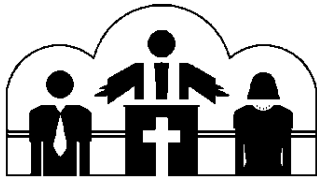

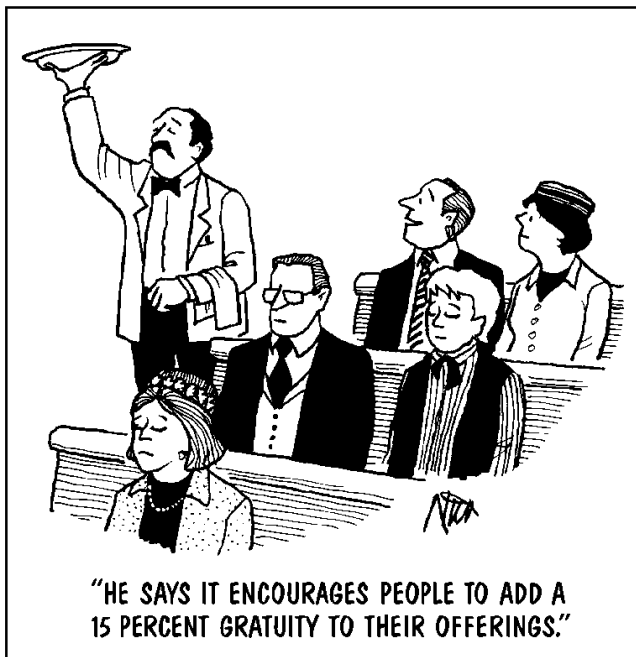
## Fall Faith Retreat
