At the Salem Church Council meeting on April 17th, council members voted to move forward with plans to provide Salem UMC with 100% renewable electric energy for our church building. The trustees are looking into which of several renewable energy programs will best serve us. We had enough volunteers step forward at the council meeting who are willing to pay the difference (for renewable electricity vs. what we use now) for a 12-month period. Once we commit to one of the renewable energy programs, more details will be available. (We will continue to heat our church with natural gas, as the boilers require this fuel.) How Would You Describe YOUR Faith?

Do you question how your faith impacts and informs your daily living? Do you wonder how your faith calls you into the world?
