
Food Pantry of Waukesha County:

RELIGIOUS DEMOGRAPHICS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY

(Presented at the Church Council Meeting, May 19, 2014)

- 2013 Population of Waukesha County: 393,843
- Median age of residents: 42 years old
- Persons 65 years of age & over: 15.3%
- Persons under 18 years of age: 23.0%
- Percentage of population in Waukesha County who say they are affiliated with a religious congregation: 66.85%

This means 1/3 of Waukesha County residents do not affiliate themselves to any religious congregation.

*Of the two thirds claiming an affiliation, this is the percentage of each denomination they adhere to:

(Adherence in this context basically means they see themselves as a follower of, supporter of, or associated with a particular religion. That does not mean they are active members or attendees. Of those whom claimed to have a religious affiliation, this is the religion with whom they claimed to "adhere" or associate themselves.)

• Mainline Protestant Denominations: 19.7%

Evangelical Churches: 22.8%

Catholic Churches: 55.9%

Orthodox Denominations: less than 1%

Other Denominations: 1.6%

There are 14 United Methodist Church congregations in Waukesha County. Only 3% of residents in the county claim to adhere to the United Methodist Church.

*These figures are based on statistics from the year 2002. We can assume, based on trends, the number of Evangelical Church's' attendees will have grown and the Mainline Protestant Denominations will have lost membership during the past decade.

What does all of this mean to Salem UMC? That is a good question to ponder. Certainly, times have changed the face of the religious demographics in Waukesha County, in our state, and in the country.
