Wisconsin Annual Conference 2015

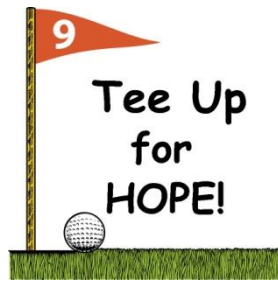
CULTIVATE & NURTURE
