


Bishop Hee-Soo Jong at Salem on Sunday, March 3



Getting to Know the Hope Center

To increase awareness of the programs available through The Hope Center in Waukesha, we will share how they run each program. This month, we are highlighting the Day Center.

What is the "Day Center"?

The Day Center operates Monday through Friday and also on weekends during the winter season. It is open from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. A hearty breakfast and hot lunch is served daily. Casual entertainment (books, movie, TV), job search assistance, medical and social assistance are available daily. The program was initiated to provide a daytime destination for the homeless, but has rapidly become a daytime destination for those who might otherwise be alone. When guests come to the Day Center they check in with an attendant and likewise check in for each meal. Only one serving is allowed at each meal.

A story from the Day Center....

A guest of the Day Center who has been coming for a while has come a long way since the first day he stepped foot in the Day Center. When he first started coming, he had just gotten out of jail. He utilized the services offered in the Day Center and other programs of Hope Center. He is a very determined man and a few short months later he had a place to live and a job. He still finds time between working to volunteer at Hope Center. Hope Center's helping hands are building hope for individuals getting back on their feet.



The Inward Look...For the Outward View Thoughts from Bishop Hee-Soo Jung

"For me, Lent is always an invitation to look inward and to reflect on my life journey. Where has God taken me this past year? What has God asked of me? Where have I fallen short? What needs to change? The spiritual disciplines of fasting and prayer help me look inward, and come to terms with what I find when I take the time to look. These spiritual practices allow time for God to reveal to me the truth of who I am becoming.

I invite you to take time for fasting and prayer, and to reflect on your life journey during this season of Lent.

The inward look leads somewhere. We do not fast and pray just to find the truth of who we are, but to discover where God wants to go with us. Peter Chrysologus, a Bishop of the early Church, preached, "The fasting man should realize what fasting is. If anyone wants God to perceive that he is hungry, he should himself take notice of the hungry."

The author of the Letter of James wrote, "What good is it my brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but do not have works? Can faith save you? If a brother or sister is naked and lacks daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and eat your fill," and yet you do not supply their bodily needs, what is the good of that? So faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead." (James 2:14-17 NRSV)

In this season of Lent, I invite you to join with me as we set aside time in our lives through prayer and fasting to take the inward look, so as to gain an outward view. We may examine ourselves so we more easily identify with the needs of others, and discover many ways God will lead us to make a difference in the world.

Prayer: God, make this Lenten journey, and the prayers and fasting, a deep and rich time for reflection and growth. And then, Holy God, bring to mind and heart the needs of the world and a fitting response. Amen.

The Trustees of Salem would like to shout out a big "THANK YOU" to the congregation for their generous giving towards new windows for the church. We need to replace the windows on the south side of the education wing which includes the offices on that side. In the narthex you'll see a display of paper stained glass windows. Every time we receive donations totaling \$100.00, a section of stained glass gets colored in. Ten sections colored in (\$1,000.00) represents a brand new window for Salem!

Families or individuals can donate any amount of money. It all adds up to new energy efficient windows for our church building. We are purchasing our windows from *Renewal by Anderson*. The window frames will be constructed of a composite, and the glass will be of *SmartSun* glass which is 45% more energy efficient in winter, 70% more efficient in the summer, and blocks 95% of harmful UV rays. This will result in energy savings to the church.
