#### \$3 Million Raised in MATCH DAY 2014

Thanks to \$750,000 in matching funds contributed by a pool of funders including the Brewers' Community Foundation and The Ceres Foundation, each donation made online on March 13, 2014 was proportionally matched based on the total amount raised. This year more than \$3 million was raised overall through the event! Sponsored by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation, the event showcases 20 participating agencies in southeast Wisconsin helping meet individuals' basic food and shelter needs. 
