We are excited to offer a new format for our church school program! Our first regular class will meet on Sunday, September 20th.

- **Church School will meet from following Children's Time until 10:10 every Sunday, except the first Sunday of every month when the children will remain for the entire worship service so they can be a part of Holy Communion. There will be no church school on this Sunday. We would like to try meeting during the worship service so families can participate in outside activities a little earlier on Sunday mornings. Our theme for September 20th and 27th will be Communion so the children are prepared for their first Communion service on October 4th. The theme for the next several months are as follows:**
 - October - Colors and symbols of the church
 - November - Christmas Program & Advent/Christmas
 - December - Christmas Program on Dec. 13, no church school on December 27
 - January - Books of the Bible/Prayers/Creeds

SARAH CIRCLE






Automate Your Giving!


