In the desert someone is shouting, "Get the road ready for the Lord!...
Then everyone will see the saving power of God." from Luke 3

John the Baptist repeats the words of the prophet Isaiah calling all those who would listen to prepare the road for the coming of the Messiah.

This is the true meaning of Advent: "coming".

I know quite well that we have made this time of the year from the "most wonderful" to the most stressful of all: too much going on, too little time, strained finances, pressure to find the perfect present, struggling to balance work and family, overeating, dealing with difficult relatives, managing your expectations.... it can be a nightmare.

Self-help books have been written about managing this stress. Exercise classes, diets, relaxing techniques have been developed to help people.

Yet, there is nothing that calms my heart and fills it with true Christmas spirit like being in worship. In worship, I experience with words, music,

symbols, and traditions the coming of God's love among us. In worship, I learn the freeing power of Christmas giving. In worship I am surrounded by the love and support of the spiritual family.
