A Note from Pastor Paola...

On the Day of Pentecost, something happened in Jerusalem where the disciples and the crowd were gathered. Here's how it was described:

“Suddenly, a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven.”



All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit, and everybody said, "What's that noise?" It was a sound like the blowing of a violent wind. It wasn't the blowing of a violent wind exactly, but it was kind of like that. It was power. Then, what looked like tongues of fire descended on them. It wasn't that. It wasn't fire exactly. What was it? It was power, personal power, the power of God, the power of the Spirit of God.

They were changed. They received the power to pray; the power to love people they couldn't love before; the power to witness; the power to give; the power to include; the power to embrace the other in the way Jesus did but human beings never do; the power to serve and stop worrying about their ego and their agenda; the power to care for the poor; the power to resist temptation; the power to build the church.

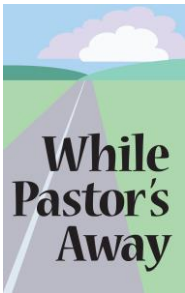


The Power of a Team

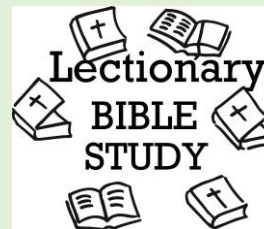
Later in June, we will have an officer from the Delafield Police Department do a security assessment of our building and grounds. There will be a one-hour video presentation and then a walk-through with our security committee identifying areas of concern.

We are also purchasing a new wheel chair for our church. Rob Roszkowski is going to try to repair the existing chair which has a bent frame. Then we would have 2 chairs available.

We would like to review some of the changes that have been made so far.

- Updated our time capsule and replaced the Cornerstone
- Disposed of old projector screen, electronic equipment, and excess furniture in the Youth Room
- Installed skylight shade in Sanctuary
- Asbestos was removed in back hallway and Youth Room
- LED lights were installed in the parking lot
- All upholstery in the Sanctuary and Library was cleaned
- Removed second piano, sold drum set
- Mapped the electrical circuits of church
- Youth Room was carpeted
- Cleaned out 90% of garage
- Removed non-working water fountain from the back of the church

Endowment Fund

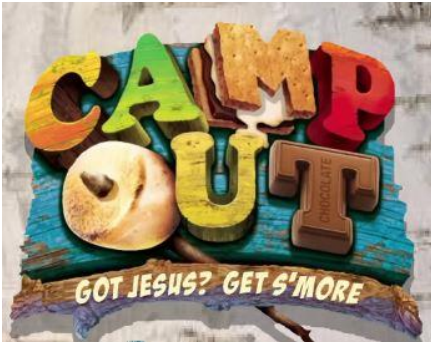
Our endowment fund provides a distribution of earnings which is used for ministry related expenditures that are requested by church ministry teams. Examples of approved funding include:

This year we have are welcoming among us as VBS director, Mary Jo Martin, who has been working with Pastor Paola in planning the event.

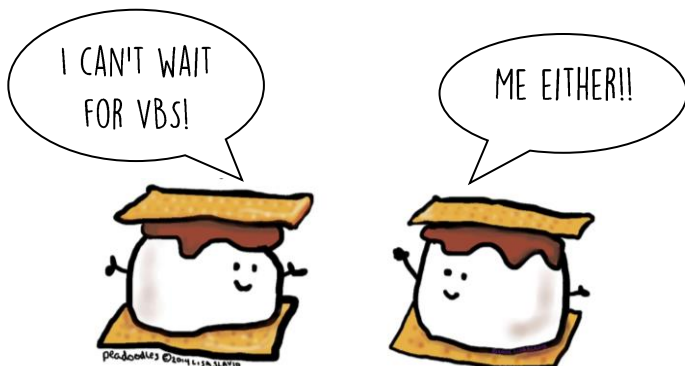
We need VOLUNTEERS:
