A note from Pastor Paola



Lenten season is here. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. Lent lasts for 40 days until we celebrate Palm Sunday on April 5th, followed by Easter Sunday on April 12th. How will you observe Lent this year? The three traditional Lenten practices are praying, fasting and giving.

This year I would like to challenge you to one more practice: paying attention to God' signs in your life.

Do you ever ask questions such as: How can I make sense of God's will for my life?

What direction I should take? Why is it so hard to hear God's voice?

I have asked these questions, and I have discovered that when I am mindful and present, I can see, hear and feel a lot more clearly God speaking to me. The problem is that

so often we are distracted by the noises inside and around us that make it very hard to see, hear and feel God's signs.

Please make time for silence this Lent.

It is in silence that we can learn how to be mindful and pay attention.

This Lent our worship series will be about recognizing God's signs in our lives. God speaks today as He did in the stories of the Old Testament. During the next six weeks, we will unpack several of these stories. We will learn how paying attention to signs from God can point us toward a greater purpose for which we were created.

Join us in worship and remember to invite a friend who may be confused, in pain, or in search of answers.

I can't wait to start this Lenten journey with you all.

The triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem as he is greeted with palm branches. Join the celebration!

Maundy Thursday, April 9

7:00 pm Service with Communion at Salem

The word "Maundy" is an Anglo-French word derived from the Latin word, "mandatum," which means "commandment." It refers to when Jesus, in the Upper Room during the Last Supper, said to his disciples: "A new commandment I give you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another." Our friends from First United Methodist Church in Waukesha will join us. There will be a combined choir.

Good Friday, April 10

7:00 pm Tenebrae Service

The Tenebrae is an ancient service that makes use of gradually diminishing light through the extinguishing of candles to symbolize the events of holy week from the triumphant Palm Sunday entry through Jesus' burial. This increasing darkness symbolizes the approaching darkness of Jesus' death and of hopelessness in the world without God. The service concludes in darkness and silence, with a final candle, the Christ candle, carried out of the sanctuary, symbolizing the death of Jesus. The service will include our choir and other special music.

Easter, April 12 9:00 AM Celebration of the Risen Lord

Tales from the Trustees

A contract has been made with a vendor to install the new entrance doors, including the Narthex and the single door on the east end. The new doors are currently being made, and we hope they will be installed either in April or May or on a succession of several warm days, whichever comes first!

The Trustees are also looking at the new entrance on the north side of our building for access to New Perspective.

The sewer connection has been delayed due to other construction concerns farther "downstream". We anticipate the connection will be completed in the next few weeks. During this time, a porta-potty will be available for a couple of weeks.

Lighting upgrades are also being planned and will happen in the near future.

Although it may seem that not much is happening, the Trustees are making careful and measured decisions, trying to use foresight both logistically and financially. Sometimes the wheels turn slowly, but for good reason.


Our Teens will help kick off Holy Week by playing handbells in worship on Sunday, April 5th.
