May 29 Our worship service will be in celebration of Memorial Day. Worship will be led by Rev. Michelle.




June 5 Pentecost Worship with Communion. We will lift up and celebrate Salem's new ministries together. Special decorations and refreshments will be part of the



One of the main jobs of the Trustees is to oversee the physical aspects of the Church which includes the interior of the building and


