
December 22nd - Mrs. Martin is teaching December 24th - Christmas Eve Service December 29th - NO SUNDAY SCHOOL

Salem's Peace Pole Matthew 5:9 says, "Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called children of God."

In this time of unrest in the world, you might like to know about Salem's outward expression of the desire for peace - peace in our families, our community, our country and the world. Our Peace Pole was sponsored by three former United Methodist Women's Circles at Salem in 2007. We wanted our community as well as our congregation and visitors to be reminded to pray for peace. On each side of the Peace Pole the words "May Peace Prevail on Earth" are written in the four languages most prominent in Waukesha County - English, Spanish, German and Hmong. Our Peace Pole links us with people all over the world who have also planted Peace Poles. There are over 250,000 Peace Poles in all continents, some in simple places such as gardens and churches, others in extraordinary ones such as the Pyramids in Egypt and the World Health Organization in Switzerland.



Salem's knitting ministry has donated 57 hats, 56 pairs of mittens, and 3 scarves to The Women's Center in Waukesha. The items were made with love and blessed by Pastor Paola. We pray they will be a source of warmth and comfort to those who receive them. Thank you to our knitters.
